Dear Students and Parents:

All Suburban Driving School strives to provide an environment where learning is fun. We are here to help students learn the rules of the road, and guide them to become safe, defensive, courteous drivers. We hope the information provided below will help answer some of your questions.

About the Class:

Our course consists of the *Illinois State required*: 30 hours of classroom instruction, 6 hours of B.T.W. (Behind the Wheel) instruction, and 6 hours of in-car observation. Our classes are fully insured, licensed, certified, and endorsed by the Office of the Secretary of State. At the end of our course, all students that have successfully completed the required hours will receive a letter from us verifying this information which can be used as a credit letter for their high school.

Classroom:

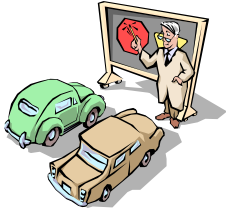
Classroom consists of a total of 30 hours of instruction. We offer four-week sessions (please see the attached schedules). Up to **four** classroom sessions may be missed, but must be made up. These hours can be made up during any of our other sessions.

B.T.W. (In Car):

During the four or five week course period, students may also schedule their behind the wheel instruction. Our drive times are very flexible and include evening and weekend hours. We offer **Free Home Pick-Up** for all scheduled driving lessons. Students can be picked up at their house, work, or school. Each student will schedule four different driving lessons which will last three hours. During their driving lessons, students will be instructed for 90 minutes, and will observe another driver for 90 minutes. This will make up the total 12 hours of the B.T.W. portion of the course (6 hours of in-car instruction & 6 hours of in-car observation).

Course Requirements:

Students must turn 15 by the end of the classroom portion of the course. All students (under age 18) must turn in documentation showing that they are eligible to take a drivers education course. The basic requirement would be providing proof of a high school report card with 8 passing grades within the last 2 semesters. Example: Any student could pass 3 classes during their first semester and 5 classes the second semester. If you are currently a freshman, you will need to have a form (supplied by our school) signed by either your Jr. High or High School. After successfully completing the course, all eligible students will receive a "completion letter" from the Secretary of State office. This letter must be presented to the Driver's License Facility when taking the driving test to get your license.

All Suburban Driving School will provide information or a form to any student if they:

- * Cannot get a copy of their high school report card

- * Have not completed one full year of high school

- * Completed or are enrolled in a G.E.D. program
- * Are home schooled

Note: Forms given out by All Suburban Driving School must be signed by a Parent, Guardian, and/or School Administrator.
